What Do I need?

- Students will be asked to complete the daily health screener at home. Students feeling physically ill should not come to school.
- Mask: Cloth mask that covers the nose and mouth. If forgotten, a mask will be provided by the school
- Water Bottle (Bottle Refilling Stations will be available, but not fountains)
- Chromebook: Students should bring their assigned Chromebook or device and charger each day. Charge your device EVERY night so it has a full charge. There are not enough plugs in the classrooms for everyone to charge.
- Textbook/ Independent Reading Book
- Backpack: As you will be carrying this all day and into each classroom, it would be beneficial to have the smallest backpack that will still accommodate your materials.
- School appropriate dress: Please see the 2020/2021 handbook for the [updated dress code \(linked here\)](#).

When do I arrive?

- Busses will arrive and students will unload shortly before school.
- The building doors will not open until 7:30 am
- Students driving or being dropped off should arrive at 7:30 am due to restrictions on students lingering in the hallways and common spaces
- Class begins at 7:37 AM.

Where do I Enter the Building?

- Busses drop off at the west lot and students enter through the Y main doors if going to the first floor or Y-Stairway doors if going to the second floor.
- Students being dropped off should be dropped off at the Main entrance loop and enter through the main entrance, door #1.
- Students who are driving will park in the student parking lot and enter through the athletic entrance, door #2.

What will Lunch look Like?

- Based on safety guidelines, and lack of capacity by fast food establishments there will be **NO** open campus for lunch.
- We will have three lunches and two lunch locations to maximize social distancing.
- Students who bring their own lunch will eat in the Auxiliary Gymnasium. Students who get school lunch will be eating in the cafeteria.
- All students will need to remain in their lunch locations and seated at their tables until dismissal.
- No personal food deliveries will be accepted at the HS during the school day (coffee, pizza, uber eats, etc.)

What will passing time look like?

- Students will be going directly from one class to another.
- Students will be carrying their backpacks, materials, and lunches with them, students will not be returning to their locker during the school day.
- Students may fill water bottles using the water filler stations. The drinking fountains will not be used.

How should I exit the building?

- The school day will end at 2:32 PM.
- All students are to leave the building by 2:42 PM to promote the health and safety guidelines.
- Students will be encouraged to leave the building using the exit nearest their last class or locker.

What is Canvas?

- Canvas is the district's new Learning Management System.
- Canvas is how students will access all digital resources for all classes whether in-person or remote.
- The Canvas calendar will show students the due dates for upcoming assignments and tests.
- Canvas is also how parents will be able to view the content, calendar, and feedback in all of their child's classes.

What about instruments or athletic gear?

- Instruments will be brought to the band lockers prior to the start of first hour.
- Athletic equipment will be brought and stored in the team locker rooms (see your coach for specific details and locations).
